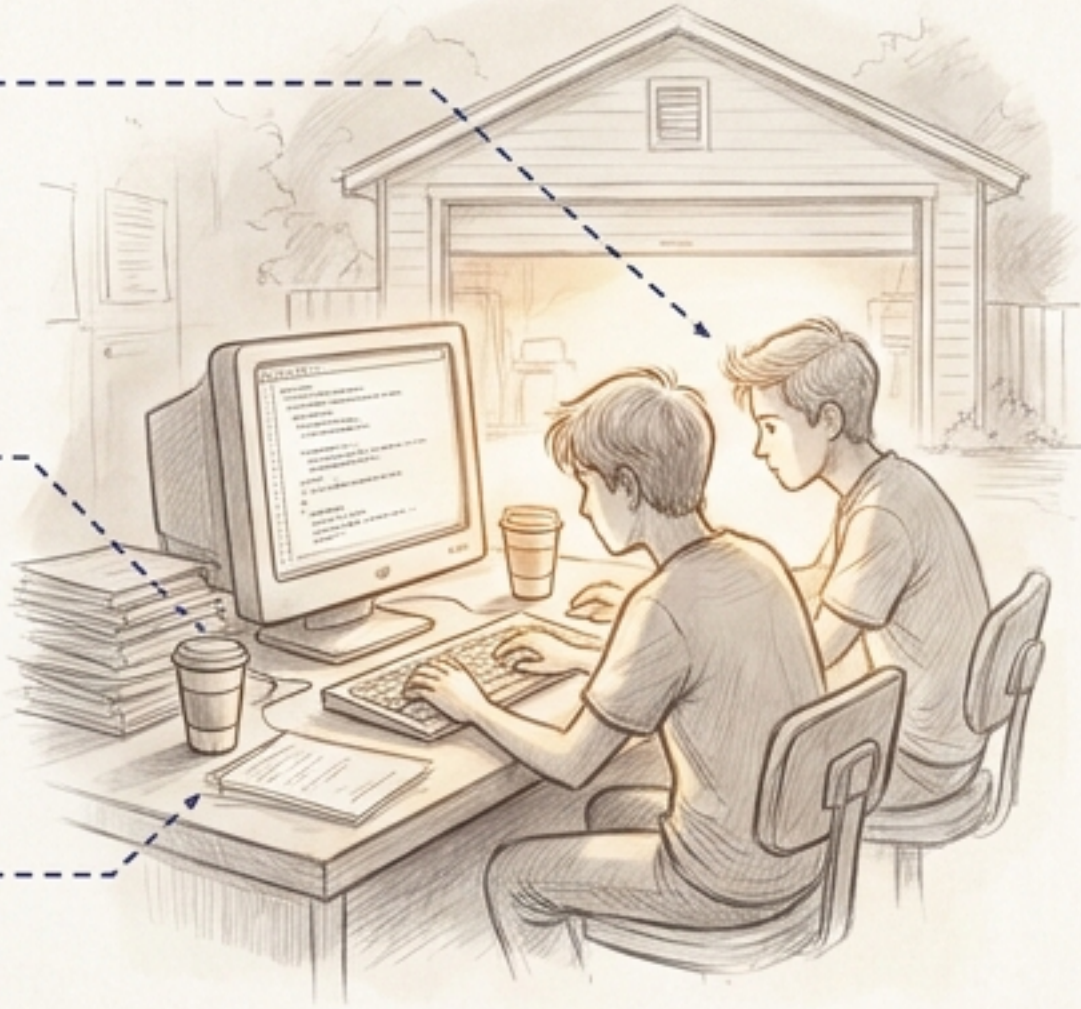

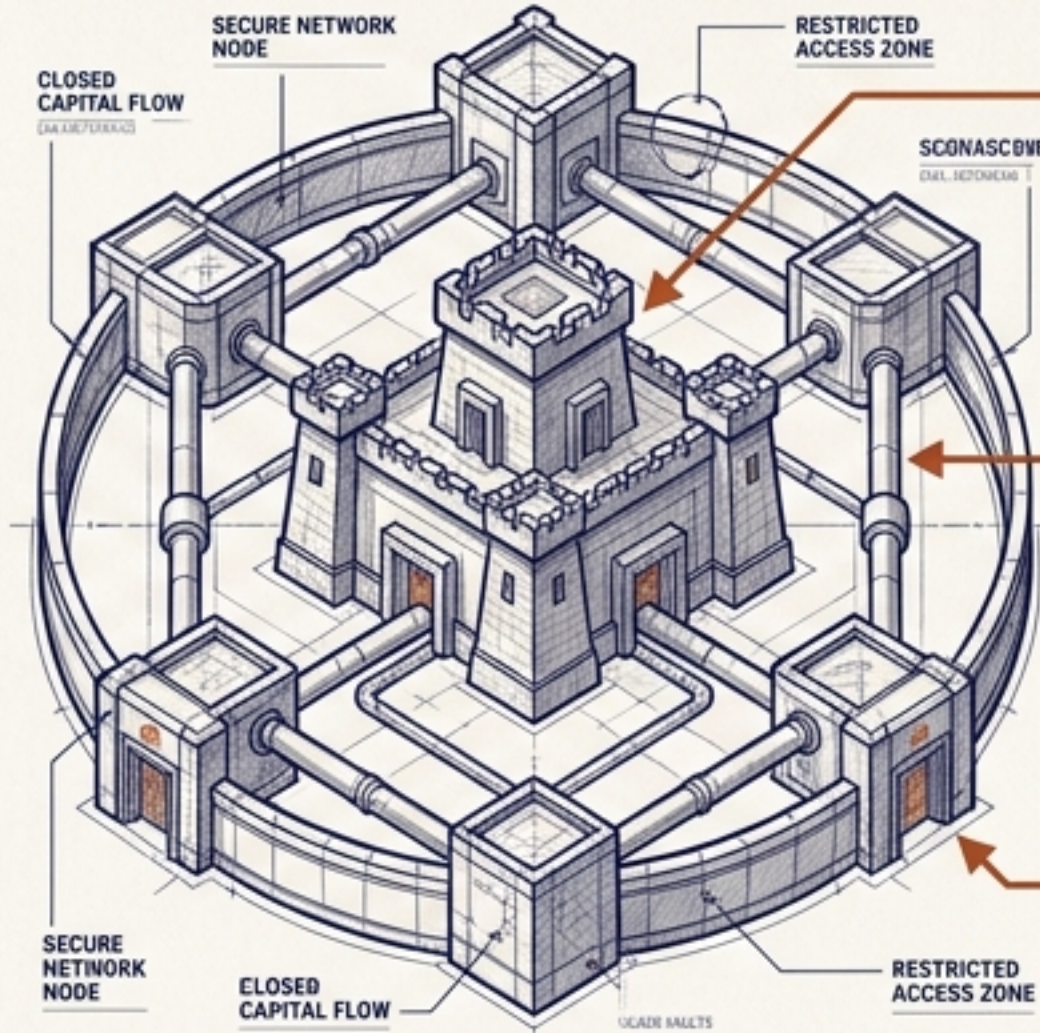

A Dark Mirror of *Mafia*

The Core:

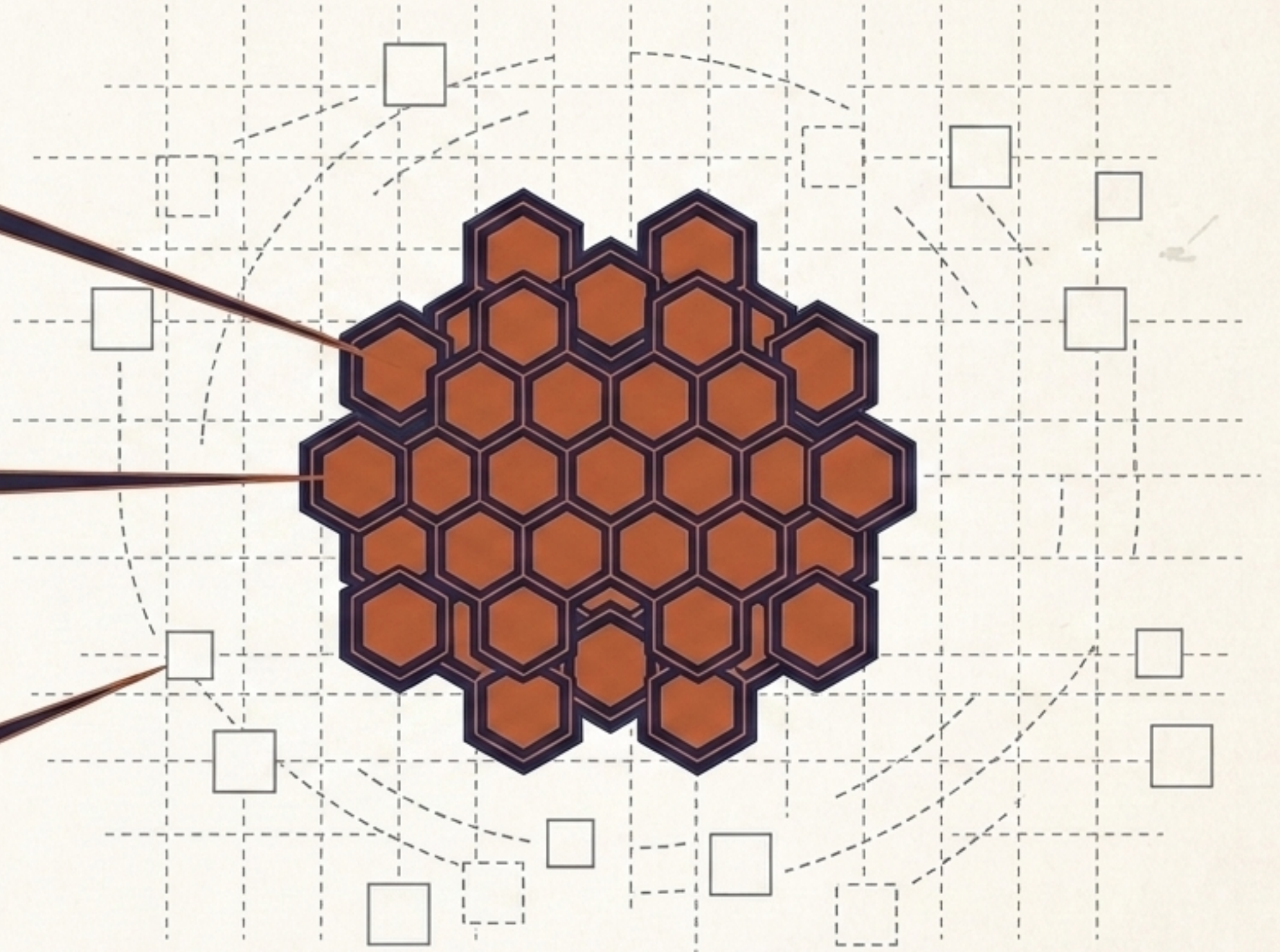
Absolute internal group solidarity. An unbreakable, algorithmic bond.

The Perimeter:

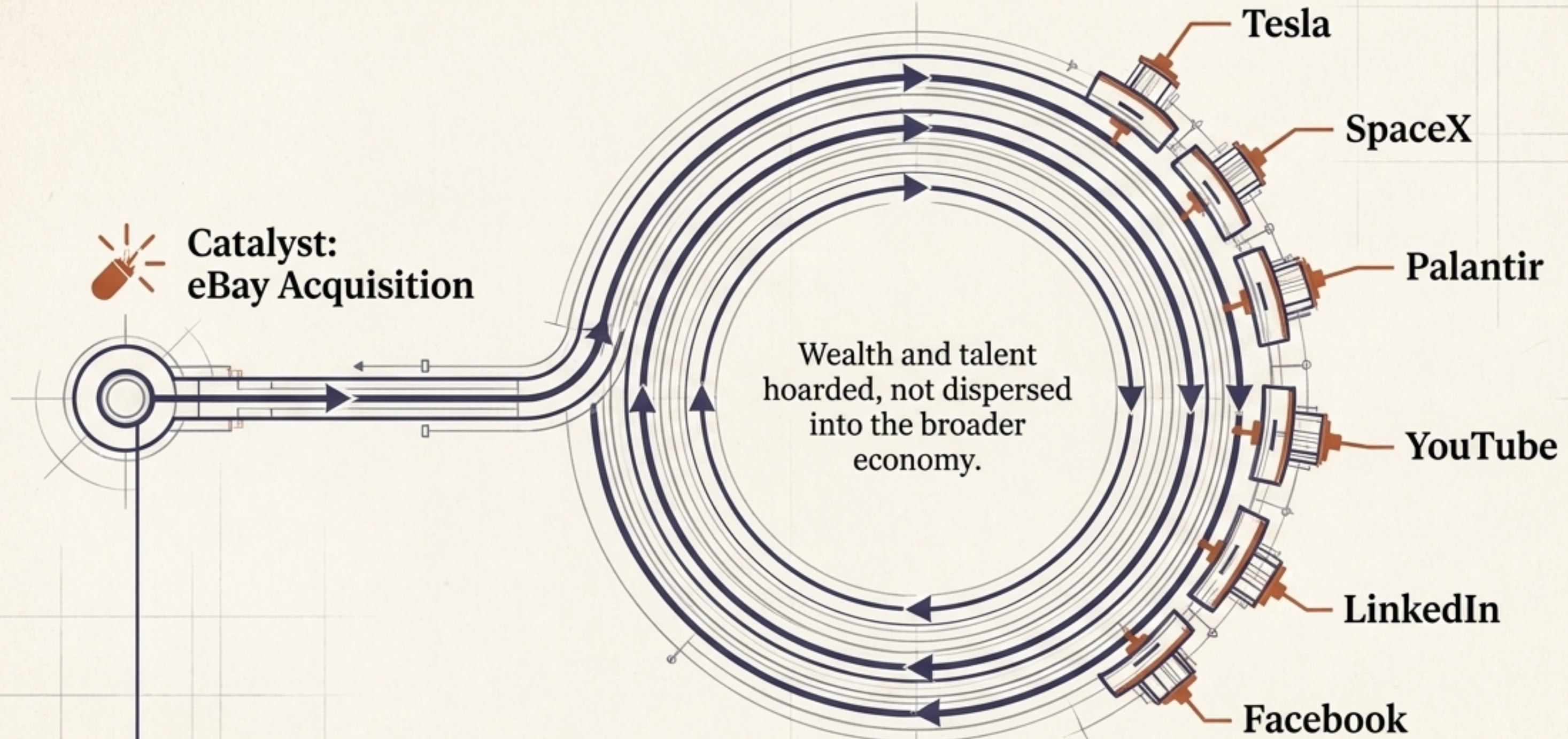
Explicitly designed to bypass traditional banking, regulation, and oversight.

The Exterior:

Legacy democracies viewed as clumsy, outdated infrastructure to be bypassed or dismantled.



The Extraction Model: Closed-Loop Capital



This was not traditional business; it was the weaponization of an exit strategy. Corporate payouts became an engine for private empires rivaling nation-states.

From Software to Statecraft

Step 1: Escape the System.
Bypass traditional legacy institutions.

Step 2: Consolidate Power.
Recycle capital internally.

Step 3: Carve Up the World.
Execute a precise division of labor to capture vital nodes of civilization.

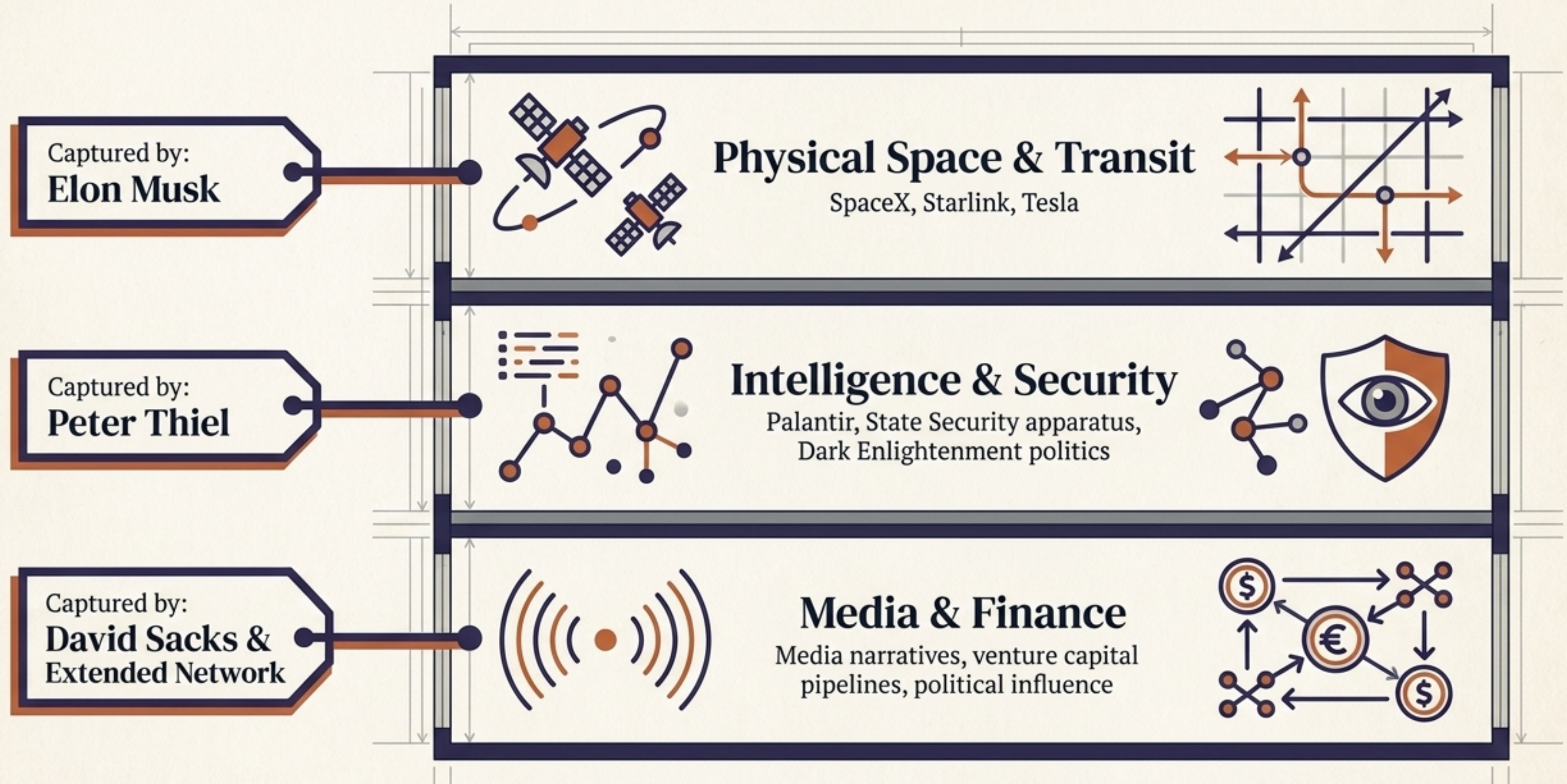

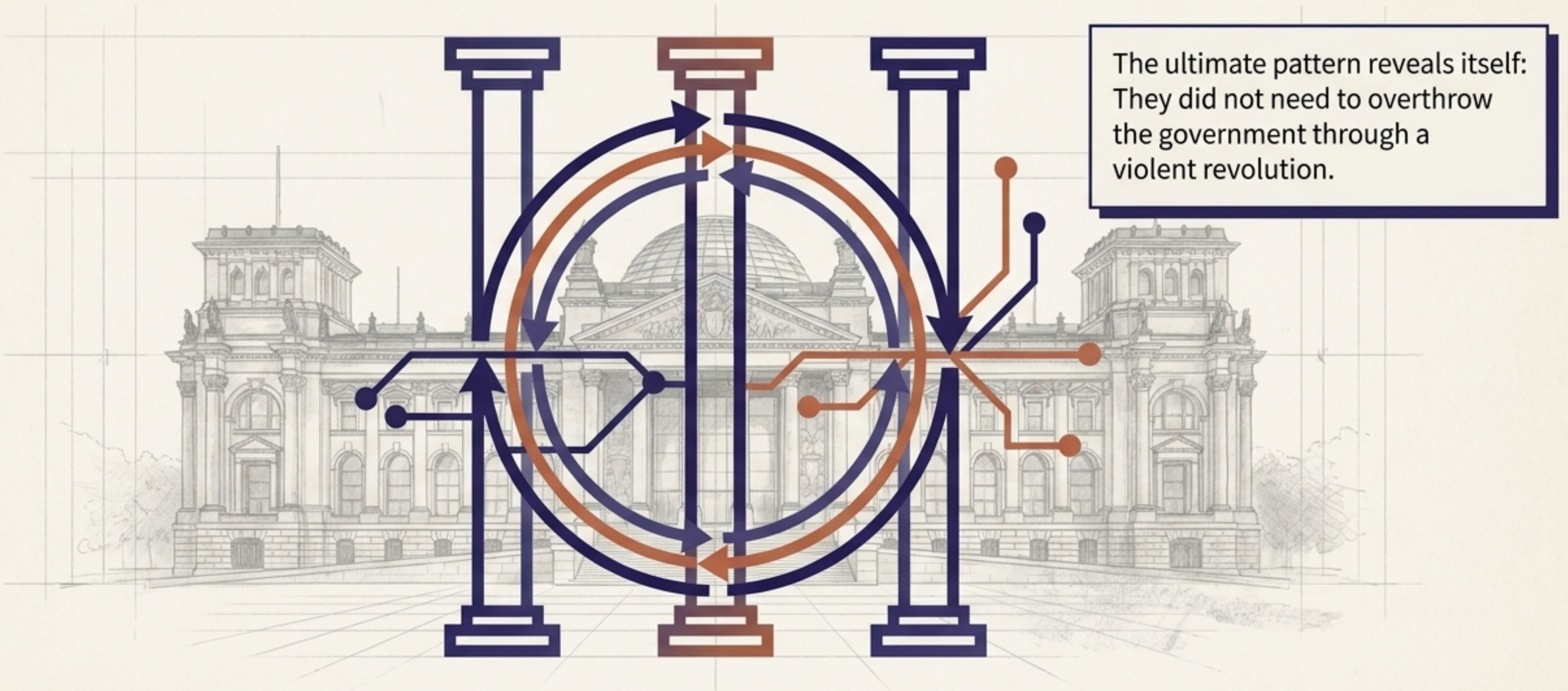

	The PayPal Mafia Model	The Sovereign Antidote
The Model	Corporate Cartel (Closed-loop syndicate)	Organic Community (True Sabornost)
The Bond	Hyper-individualistic, algorithmic, and transactional	Rooted in soil, heritage, and shared faith
The Goal	Wealth extraction and global capital dominance	Mutual survival of ordinary people
The Human Element	Human beings reduced to 'data points' and 'users'	Human beings as rooted citizens
